

RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MELBOURNE MUNICIPAL BAND ASSOCIATION, INC.
ADOPTED JANUARY 25, 1987
A Corporation Not for Profit

WE, the undersigned members of MELBOURNE MUNICIPAL BAND ASSOCIATION, INC., hereby form ourselves and our successors into a corporation not for profit under the corporate name of Melbourne Municipal Band Association, Inc., and hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be Melbourne Municipal Band Association, Inc. and shall be located at Melbourne, Brevard County, Florida, until such time as said location may be changed as provided in the By Laws.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to promote band music; to encourage the study and practice of music; to establish and maintain a municipal band; to encourage participation in municipal band activities; to foster and encourage social and cultural relationships related to its musical endeavors and to advance the musical and cultural appreciation of society in such geographical areas as may be served; and to function as a charitable organization.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the purposes for which the Melbourne Municipal Band Association, Inc. is organized are exclusively charitable, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE III

There shall be three types of members, namely: Participating Member, Patron Member and Sustaining Member. Participating members shall be those individually who actively participate in the musical activities of the Melbourne Municipal Band. Patron Members shall be any person who shall evidence an interest in the welfare of the Melbourne Municipal Band.

Sustaining Members shall be any individual, business association, company or corporation who shall evidence an interest in the welfare of and shall assist in the continuance and maintenance of the Melbourne Municipal Band. All Members of each type shall have one vote at general membership meetings of the association. The manner of admission and qualifications of members of each type, as well as their removal, shall be a stated in the By Laws.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees who shall be elected, in the manner prescribed by the By Laws, annually at a general membership meeting of the corporation.

The Board of Trustees shall consist of not less than five members as determined by the By Laws, not less than three of which shall be Participating Members. In addition to the elected membership, the Bandmaster shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees shall be governed by the following officers, who shall be elected in such manner as the Board may determine within their membership; Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

All Board members shall take office at the close of the General Membership Meeting at which elected and shall continue in office until their removal, resignation or successor member may be elected, all as prescribed in the By Laws.

The Bandmaster shall be selected and appointed in such manner as may be determined by the Board of Trustees.

All general day-to-day matters of the corporation shall be conducted by the Bandmaster, with advice and counsel of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, as may be more specifically provided in the By Laws.

ARTICLE VII

The names of the officers of the Board of Trustees who manage the affairs of the Corporation until after the first election under this Charter were:

ARTICLE IX

The By Laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded on the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of those present at any meeting of the Board of Trustees called for that purpose, after ten days notice given to the several members of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE X

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in a like manner as provided above for the amendment of By Laws, provided that any such amendment to these articles must be forwarded to the Secretary of the State of Florida for filing and approval before the same shall become effective.

ARTICLE XI

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, state or local government for exclusive public purposes.

ARTICLE XII

The amount of indebtedness of liability to which the Corporation may be at any time subject itself shall be as specified in the By Laws.

ARTICLE XIII

The amount of the value of the real estate which the Corporation may hold shall be as stated in the By Laws.

The amended Articles of Incorporation are appended to and made a part of the original Articles of Incorporation dated April 7, 1966.
